You'll want to start your day at the International Bakery on 24th Street for the best pan dulce (essentially a Mexican donut) in the city!

2 Time to take a stroll

Next you'll walk down the street to the World of Mexican Pottery shop. They have beautiful, unique pottery and artwork from Mexico.

3 Can we stop for a quick bite?

After visiting the shops along 24th street you may be hungry. Taqueria Tijuana and Taqueria El Rey (corner of 24th & Q) are my personal favorites for street tacos, and authentic Mexican food. If you're wanting seafood, go just across the street to El Dorado, or slightly further south down 24th street to the Triple D famous restaurant, Joe Tess.

4 Anything I can't miss?

Make sure to visit south 24th Street over Cinco de Mayo weekend. There are parades, performances, food vendors and more. This is a party you do NOT want to miss!

5 But one more thing!

On the way home, make sure to stop at Jacobo's (24th & L) for some chips & salsa, enchiladas, pork carnitas, tamales and more. If there is a line to get to the counter, that is normal. The food is just THAT good. Bring your cash, as that is all they accept!
