

# Cass County Nebraska Economic Development Corporation 2014 - 2018 Economic Impact Analysis

### 1. Overview

This report provides the economic impact of the Cass County Nebraska Economic Development Corporation's (CCNEDC) program from 2014 through 2018 Q3. Working with our community partners, CCNEDC landed 8 projects, supporting the creation of 83 new jobs and capital investment of \$14.26 million in Cass County.

## 2. Summary

Since 2014, CCNEDC has worked in partnership with communities to bring new projects and investment to Cass County. This analysis shows a snapshot of the economic impact of those cumulative projects on the 2018 Cass County economy. If CCNEDC did not exist, the 2018 economy would be missing the gains described below.

- Economic activity generated by CCNEDC in the area **added about \$14.2 million to the local economy** in 2018
  - Includes activity directly related to the companies' operations, addition of new jobs, additional business-to-business spending, and associated "spillover" activity from increased household spending
- 83 new jobs at the projects support the activities of an additional 28 workers in our community
  - Additional workers include food service, hospitals, retail, physicians, accountants, banks, insurance agencies, etc.
- The local economy sees an annual boost to total compensation of about \$4.8 million (including wages, benefits & proprietor income) from economic activity directly related to the project, additional business-to-business spending, and additional household spending
- Capital investment from CCNEDC projects supported 75 construction workers, an additional 16 workers in other industries, and adds \$1.87 million to the local economy each year from 2014 to 2018 (\$9.3 mm total)

  - o Snapshot of CCNEDC's economic impact in 2018 dollars
  - Industry Category
    - Assigned an industry to each of the landed projects
  - o Jobs
    - Used the number of new jobs created by the landed CCNEDC projects
  - See Table 2 for industry groups and the associated Type SAM multipliers and number of new jobs
- Economic Impact of Construction
  - Assumed construction costs for new projects were 50% of total capital investment, based on the average ratio of capital investment to land & equipment costs
  - o Criteria
    - IMPLAN Sector: 57
    - Type SAM: 1.318257
    - \$7,040,000 in construction (building value) over 5 years
