

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Fremont Inland Port Site is located approximately 15 minutes from Northwest Omaha. The Fremont Logistics Hub provides up to 1,669 acres of flat ground along Highway 275/West Dodge Expressway. All utilities are present or within 1 mile. There is rail access to Union Pacific mainline on the north border of the site. This site was recently designated as a Inland Port Authority.



#### **SEWER**

#### Line Size & Location:

24' sewer line on site, site is adjacent to treatement plant. Industrial strength line available on select pads. 30'.

#### **System Capacity:**

Fremont Department of Utilities provides sewer; Plant capacity is 11.35 MGPD; Average daily use is 4 GMD

#### **WATER**

#### Line Size & Location:

16" water line 2.5 miles west of the site.

#### **System Capacity:**

Fremont Department of Utilities provides water; 21 MGD capacity; average daily use is 4.6 MGD

#### **TELECOM**

#### Carriers:

Five fiber providers with diverse paths; 3 providers on site

#### Capacity:

10+ Gig Local & long haul

Site has local distribution with the ability to grow; city has 128 MW capacity with 40 MW Peaking Turbine; connected to Omaha Public Power District for additional capacity
