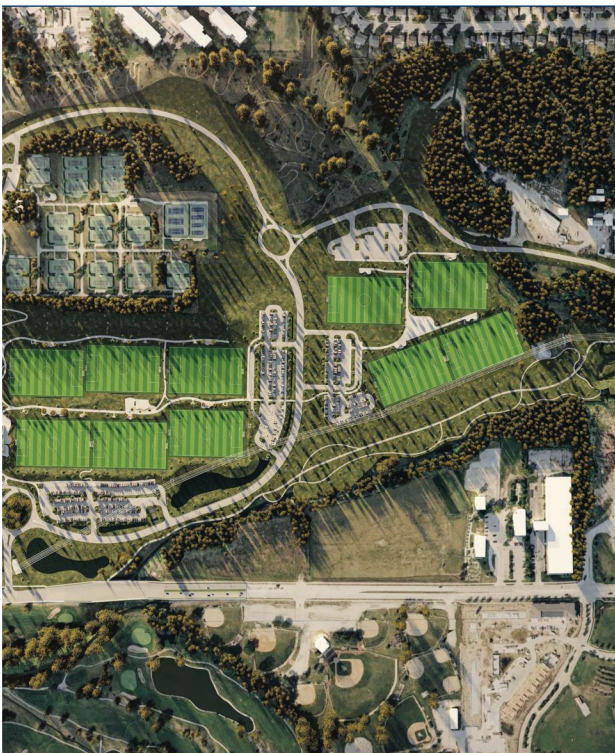

**Public Safety Headquarters at the Crossroads**

**\$155 million** on the ballot

NO PROPERTY TAX LEVY INCREASE

- Brings police and fire administration and operational functions together for the first time, which will enhance efficiency.
- The current police headquarters is over 50 years old. Structural steel with spray-on asbestos fireproofing hampers renovation and presents a major health risk.
- Houses about 300 administrative personnel. Not a police precinct or fire station. No police cruisers or fire apparatus would deploy from there.
- Adds a shared Real Time Operations Center, Emergency Medical Services support, a public plaza and indoor training space. Anticipated opening 2030.

**\$30 million** on the ballot

NO PROPERTY TAX LEVY INCREASE

- City officials plan 16 synthetic turf fields, which will allow Omaha to compete for regional and national tournaments.
- For a city Omaha's size, local players deserve a state-of-the-art facility right here at home.
- Families play closer to home, and Omaha competes with surrounding markets on tournament revenue.
- Trails, a mountain bike system and an updated Kelley Fields follow in the longer-term vision.
